
JUST THE FACTS ABOUT CATARACTS

IT'S NATURAL

AS WE AGE, THE LENSES IN OUR EYES BECOME CLOUDY, OBSCURING OUR VISION. THAT'S WHAT THE FOLKS IN THE LAB COATS CALL CATARACTS – AND IT'S A COMMON PHENOMENON.



SO HOW CAN YOU TELL IF YOU HAVE CATARACTS?

It's a gradual process, so you may not notice any symptoms until the cataract is severe enough to distort light as it enters your eye.³ Here are some signs that you might have cataracts:

- Cloudy, blurry or dim vision³
- Increasing difficulty with night vision³
- Sensitivity to light and glare³
- Frequent changes in eyeglass or contact lens prescription³
- Fading or yellowing of colors³
- Seeing rings around lights³
- Double vision in a single eye³

SURGERY REMOVES CATARACTS


Cataracts aren't preventable. But here's the good news: THAT MAKES IT ONE OF THE MOST COMMON SURGERIES⁴

ACCORDING TO A TELEPHONE SURVEY OF 1,000 RANDOMLY SELECTED AARP MEMBERS⁵:






said they were less dependent on glasses for distance vision after surgery




were pleasantly surprised by the improvement they experienced with their vision
